& rough saw the Brig Gazelle
& spoke the sch Adela Chase
latter had taken nothing since
we spoke him last so ends this day
- "16th Lat 17.35 Long 21.30 Heavy gale &
very rough sea does not
increase saw a school of
Blackfish so ends this day

& rough saw the Adela Chase
& Gazelle Capt. Jarrara & Capt. Bonem
went on board the latter
so ends this day
- "18th Lat 18.30 Long 23.05 Strong breeze
& rough Adela Chase & Gazelle
in sight so ends this day
- "19th Lat 18.04 Long 23.21 Heavy gale
& very rough quite smoky
so ends this day
- "20th Lat 17.36 Long 24.00 Heavy gale
Peter Getow raised a school of
small whales two rows to bow
so ends this day
- "21st Lat 17.21 Long 24.27 Very strong breeze
& rough sighted St Antone
so ends this day
- "22nd Lat 17.50 Long 26.00 Very strong breeze
& rough broke out water
so ends this day
- "23rd Lat 16.54 Long 25.37 Moderate breeze
St Antone in sight Course
south by east so ends this day
- "24th Lat 15.27 Long 24.53 Moderate breeze
sighted Frogo & Brasso saw a
small coasting sch so ends this day
- "25th Come to anchor here at Brava
about ten o'clock scrubbed ship
out side so ends this day
