heavy rain in forenoon so ends this day

" 25th Lat 35.48 Long 74.29 Very light breeze
repaired Foresail so ends this day

" 26th Lat 36.05 Long 74.05 Mate raised
whales - Lourel & S.B. struck
maid Boat chased off & struck
saw both will make about
fifty each so ends this day

" 27th Lat 36.16 Long 73.36 Strong breeze
cut both masts Capt Jof C.W. Morse
came on board so ends this day

" 28th Lat 36.18 Long 73.33 Calm very heavy
tempest during night Capt Rod
of Brig D. Small came on ^{board} ^{and}
stayed for a little while
C.W. Morse in sight so ends this day

" 29th Lat none Long none Very severe
gale with heavy squalls of
rain cooled down in afternoon
have stowed about forty lbs
one whaling Bark in sight
so ends this day

" 30th Lat 36.05 Long 75.17 finished stowing
down 44 lbs. saved sail in sight so ends this day

May 31st Lat 36.38 Long 74.08 Light breeze finished
stowing down whales - made 23 lbs -
gained C.W. Morse Robout Beef
Water & Molasses - so ends this day & month

June 1st Lat 36.18 Long 74.00 Light breeze gained
the C.W. Morse saw two whales - Carcasses
so ends this day

" 2nd Lat none Long none Very light breeze
rain in afternoon C.W. Morse & two
others Chs in sight so ends this day

" 3rd Lat 36.13 Long 72.48 Very light breeze
one Whaling sch & one Bark at boiling
then repairing by sail so ends this day

" 4th Lat 36.45 Long 72.23 Light breeze
but smoky saw a sch boiling
so ends this day

" 5th Lat 36.18 Long 72.08 Moderate breeze
John Monterio raised whales -
going to mindward very fast
did not lower so ends this day

" 6th Lat 37.10 Long 72.08 Strong breeze
Frank Jof raised whales - Howard
& M. struck out him in &
Manoel Coea raised whales
again soured & mate struck
both about 40 lbs whales
last one sunk & have slather
it a steam on a line
so ends this day
