

- June 7th Lat 37.50 Long 71.41 Moderate breeze took the whale along side & put fluke chain on & hauled several bladders in sight so ends this day
- " 8th Lat none Long none Strong breeze with some rain cut the whale started work after dinner stowed down some oil several sail in sight so ends this day
- " 9th Lat 38.20 Long none Strong breeze & very rough finished hauling a: & stowed down part of it so ends this day
- " 10th Lat 37.20 Long 72.46 Moderate breeze finished stowing down whales made 72 lbs - broke out riders and stowed aft one skin in sight so ends this day
- " 11th Lat 37.51 Long 72.30 Calm nearly all day several sail in sight so ends this day
- " 12th Lat 37.06 Long 73.00 Calm all day saw a dead whale but it was no good several sail in sight so ends this day
- " 13th Lat 36.47 Long 72.53 Very light breeze Harold Silva raised whales towards ship but then got into a carcass slick & turned to windward could not strike so ends this day

- June 14 Lat 36.40 Long 72.59 Calm Antonio Silva raised whales - at daylight going very fast toward but did not see them from the boats three whales in sight repaired Taysail so ends this day
- " 15th Lat 36.50 Long 73.05 Very light breeze broke out Beef spoke the E.B. Cornwall & jammed the Sarah Hunt went on board of the Bark Pictorus - of N.Y. several whales in sight so ends this day
- " 16th Lat 36.50 Long none Very light breeze & Calm heavy rain showers in afternoon so ends this day
- " 17th Lat none Long none Moderate Gale came on in the early part of the night with heavy rain continuing through the night & all day about four o'clock had a squall of great violence carrying away main Taysail & bursting fore stay sail moderated a little after half an hour but still continues to blow very hard - Bar stands 29.7 so ends this day
- " 18th Lat 36.31 Long 73.59 Strong breeze & rough but moderating so ends this day
- " 19th Lat 36.42 Long 73.05 Light breeze Broke out sent letters so ends this day
