

June 20th Lat 36.58 Long 72.29 Moderate
 breeze refreshing Trysail two whaling
 Le's in sight so ends this day

"21st" Lat 37.03 Long 71.36 Moderate
 breeze Capt of the Alcyon
 came on board in the morning
 in the afternoon commenced
 the President & Golden City
 raised whales. Loured & Capt
 of the Golden City struck first
 followed by the Capt & mate of
 the E. S. Smith & others think there
 is six whales all told
 so ends this day

"22nd" Lat 37.42 Long 71.08 Strong breeze
 cut in the whale run took
 & started boiling other ships
 are not in sight so ends this day

"23rd" Lat 38.10 Long 71.27 Very strong breeze
 & rough finished boiling last
 night & stowed down today
 took out Flour Whale made
 15 H - so ends this day

"24th" Lat none Long none Heavy gale
 from N. & very rough
 took out Boil so ends this day

"25th" Lat 37.21 Long 72.13 Light breeze
 several sail in sight
 leak does not increase
 so ends this day

June 26th Lat 37.11 Long 72.10 Calm nearly all
 day several sail in sight broke out
 Brat & repaired Trysail
 so ends this day

"27th" Lat 36.55 Long 70.54 Strong breeze
 in the morning freshening
 into a heavy gale in the
 afternoon raised the Alcyon
 & Mr. Grozier whaling former
 got one whale so ends this day

"28th" Lat 37.34 Long 70.42 Very strong
 breeze & very rough Peter Gibson
 raised 7 whales - Loured &
 Omaty struck a 25th bull
 2nd mate struck a cow mate
 whale say to windward boat
 got the heaving so bad would
 scarce float had to cut took
 2nd mate's whale along side &
 cut it in so ends this day

"29th" Lat 37.25 Long 71.53 Light breeze
 repaired waist Brat & boiled
 but whale several steamers
 in sight so ends this day

"30th" Lat 37.10 Long 72.12 Light breeze
 sighted the President near
 down Capt Edwards came
 on board for breakfast then
 Capt. Brown went over
 these 4 ships did not get
 about 11th p.m. our ship took
 it on board & stowed it down
 with what we had on deck
 so ends this day & month
