

Aug 15th Lat 35.37 Long 74.01 Strong breeze
& squally with rain in
forenoon moderating in
the P.M. took out four
so ends this day

"16th Lat 35.40 Long 73.46 Very light breeze
Ship Kuper raised a dead
whale picked it up & cut it in
it had been dead but a very
short time from whales in sight
started to boil so ends this day

"17th Lat 35.52 Long 72.57 Moderate breeze
Manuel Correa raised whale
bowl but did not get fast
Alegre & one other Sch appeared
but got nothing finished towing
& showed down whale made
about 20 lbs - so ends this day

"18th Lat none Long none Gale from
N.E. with heavy rain in P.M.
Fore sail torn so ends this day

"19th Lat 34.03 Long 73.11 Light breeze
Rising Sun Sarah Hunt E.B.
Cornwell & Golden City in sight
Gannet the two latter
did not increase Manuel
Joseph very sick with consumption
so ends this day

"20th Lat none Long none Heavy rain
nearly all day three Schs in
sight so ends this day

Aug 31st Lat 36.10 Long 74.09 Had a very severe
gale during the latter part of the
night & early morning moderating
in afternoon so ends this day

"22nd Lat none Long none Very heavy
gale from N.E. with much
rain burst clew of Jynoid
so ends this day

"23rd Lat none Long none Blowing a
Hurricane all day extreme heavy
sea running with laboring heavily
& apparently making water free
lost the waist boat about half past
five wind shifted from E. by N to
S.E. no sign of its moderating yet
so ends this day

"24th Lat 37.28 Long 71.57 Strong breeze & very
rough Hurricane commenced to
moderate about four o'clock this
morning a very large sea came
about about eleven o'clock but
night smashing the gang board
galle towing or larger hole in
the main sail & taking the
S.B. this morning raised a large
Bark in distress saw for
her she proved to be the
Station Bark Vincenzo Galatola
waterlogged succeeded after
several attempts in getting off
her crew of eleven men
so ends this day
