

Aug 25th Lat 39.05 Long 72.09 Moderate breeze
S.W. Cores A. scraping masts &
working in rigging Charles Gony
refused to mast the bends of
the vessel when he was told
so I took hold of him to put
him there when he struck
me which caused a fight
so ends this day

" 26th Lat none Long none Moderate
breeze S.W. Thick fog sounders
at nine o'clock 39 fathoms at
12 o'clock 32 at four 27 fathoms
heard several fog horns
sounded ship so ends this day

" 27th Lat none Long none Very light
breeze Thick fog fog raised for a few
minutes about ten o'clock raised
Block Island bearing N.N.W. about 4
miles off followed the soundings
in to about 12 fathoms so ends this day

" 28th Lat none Long none Thick fog
dropped anchor at 12 o'clock
last my net & layed till this
morning at eight fog raised at
9 o'clock then chickens light
sailed bearing S.E. 9 miles
weighed & took Tilly Nellie &
others

May 22nd Sailed from Edgartown today
Tug Storm King towed us out
light N.E. wind out of sight of
land at sunset so ends this day

" 23rd Lat none Long none very light
wind & foggy one stopper
appeared out today his name
is Joseph Barrows age 14 so ends this day

24th Lat none Long none Strong breeze in
first part calm in last part
thick fog so ends this day

25th Lat 38.5 Long 71.29 Strong
breeze all day Lat 38 ship
at 6 p.m. so ends this day

26th Lat 38.56 Long 71.36 Light
wind in first part calm last
part saw one schooner
so ends this day

27th Lat 37.33 Long 72.41 This day
came near with fine weather
saw 6 boats fish going fast
breeze & West so ends this day

28th Fine weather Lat 37.41 Long 72.48
saw 3 steamers saw grasshoppers
so ends this day

29th This day commences with strong breeze
first part calm last part
Lat 38.14 Long 74.17 so ends
this day

30th Lat 37.29 This day commen-
ces with strong breeze in first
part squally last so ends this day
