These 24 hours Pleasant Weather employed in cutting in the a fore Whale finished cutting maine bale and took eight for more S C

Remarks on Board *Thursday* March the 17 1841

At these 24 hours Pleasant Weather and Pleasant breeze from the South employed in Boiling at 1 P.M. Spinn Whales Went of in Pen Suit of them but not every house spoke the Bank Clairson of St. Bede 24 months 1200 Lat 34° 01' *Glabe*

Remarks on Board *Friday* March the 18 1841

These 24 hours first Part variable fine Weather latter Part stiff breeze and squally employed in Boiling Lat 33° 52'

Remarks on Board *Saturday* March the 19 1841

At these 24 hours Pleasant Weather at 7 P.M. finished Boiling at 9 A.M. but caught the reefs and set top product Sales S C Lat 33° 46' Long 43° 24'

Remarks on Board *Sunday* March the 20 1841

At these 24 hours light Winds and Pleasant Weather at 9 A.M. saw the Land Massachusetts S C

Remarks on Board *Monday* March the 21 1841

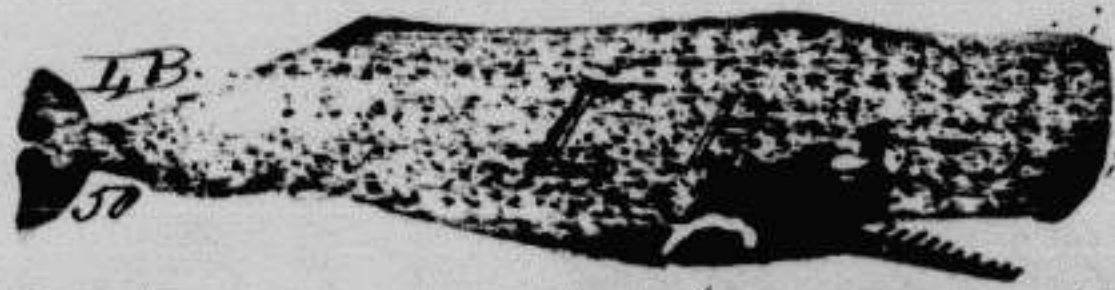
At these 24 hours Pleasant breeze from the South and Pleasant Weather steaming in to make the Land at 6 P.M. left to the Wind took in top gallant sails at daylight. Keel of a gain so ends the day

Remarks on Board *Tuesday* March the 22 1841

These 24 hours light Winds from the South and Pleasant Weather at 2 P.M. 2 Boats Went in to make a fishing at 6 returned Boats full of Steaming to the S. & W. the Watches employed in looking the Shore Spars Lat 34° 08'

Remarks on Board *Wednesday* March the 23 1841

These 24 hours Pleasant breeze from the South and Pleasant Weather at 4 P.M. saw Spinn Whales Went of in Pen Suit of them but did not get near them at 7 took in sail at daylight made Sale at 10 A.M. saw Spinn Whales Went of in Pen Suit of them and part 2 of them and got the Bow Boat Stove by the Whales S C 7 Whales in sight
