

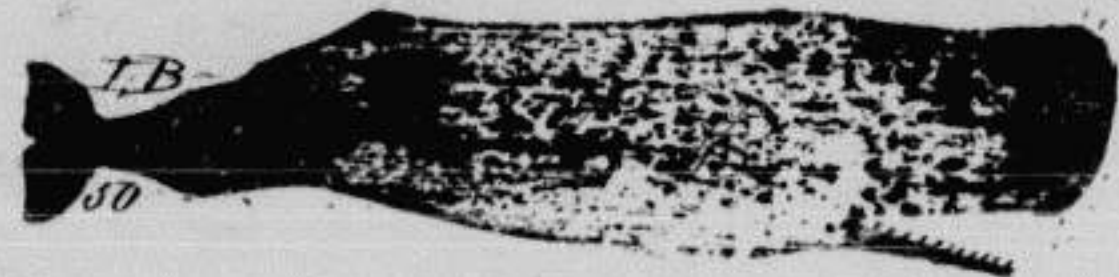

These 24 hours light breeze and Cloudy Steaming to the S & S Sails in sight to all the land in sight
Musselrocks employed in disport Sails & C

Remarks on Board Thursday April the 22 1841

These 24 hours Comes with light Wind and Cloudy at 1 P.M. Sails Spinnaker Sails Went off in Ben Suit of them and got 2 of them at 7 got them a long side took in Sails and made Preparations for cutting at daylight Comes cutting but a ship standing south & C

These 24 hours Comes with stiff breeze from the south finished cutting in the a horse Whales employed in Burying mounds and latter Part moonlight breeze and Pleasant Weather

Remarks on Board Saturday April the 24 1841

These 24 hours Pleasant Weather employed in Burying & C Musselrocks in sight Bore East Ben compass

Remarks on Board Sunday April the 25 1841

These 24 hours Stiff breeze from the S & S and Sails finished Burying Lat 55° 12 South

Remarks on Board Monday April the 26 1841

At these 24 hours Stiff breeze and raged Sails and Showers of rain employed in Steaming down the
Lat 54° 00 South

Remarks on Board Tuesday April the 27 1841

These 24 hours Comes with Stiff breeze from the south employed in Steaming down at 4 P.M. kept of South at 10 P.M. finished Steaming down and worked the Ship at night the reef and bet the gullant Sails
Lat 51° 00 South Long 81° 00 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday April the 28 1841

These 24 hours Stiff breeze from the S & S and Sails Steaming North Lat 49° 00 Long 83° 00 West

Remarks on Board Thursday April the 29 1841

These 24 hours Comes with Stiff breeze from the south and Sails "Whitten" at 11 P.M. took in top gullant Sails and left to the "Wind" with the main yard a hook at daylight kept of South a gain saw the Land at 10 P.M. latter Part light Winds the Watches employed in setting the rigging to C
Lat 26° 00 South Long 90° 00 West
