Commenced with moderate winds and pleasant weather. Employed in reading A ship in sight off our weather quarter. A M. Commenced breaking out in the fore hold. to stow down Oil. Nothing in sight. Lat 6.54 south

Tuesday August 31st

This day begins with strong wind and pleasant weather. Employed in stowing in the fore hold A M. Commenced stowing again. Latitude 6.09 Longitude 101.19

Wednesday September 1st

This 24 hours. Commenced with fresh breezes and pleasant weather. Employed in stowing Oil in fore hold. A M begins with fresh breezes. pleasant weather. Employed in breaking out between decks. No Ends. this day Long 101.00 West Lat 05.54 south

Thursday Sept 2d

Pleasant trades and pleasant weather. A M begins with light winds. Set the reefs out the topsails and set 3 topgallant sails flying jib. Staring N. N. W. Nothing in sight. Lydia Hazard Long 101.01 West Lat 5.22 south

Friday Sept 3d

This day begins with a strong trade and pleasant weather. Employed in breaking out in after hold. after provisions. A M. Employed in repairing the main topsail. Continued pleasant weather. so ends this 24 hours. Lat 06.04 south Long 101.55 West

Saturday Sept 4th

This 24 hours. Light winds and pleasant weather. Employed on the main topsail Middle parts light winds. A M. begins with pleasant weather. Nothing in sight. Lat 05.46 Long 101.15 West

Sunday Sept 5th

Commenced strong trades and pleasant weather. Employed in clearing up decks Staring by the wind. N. W. by E. A M. plenty of porpoises in sight. Lat 03.27 south Long 99.22 West

Monday Sept 6th

Commenced with pleasant weather. and fresh breezes. Employed in reading. All sail out. nothing in sight. sturing to the eastward. A M. pleasant. Lat 1.55 South Long 97.56 West

Tuesday Sept 7th

This day Commences. quite pleasant weather. And light winds. Employed in ships duty nothing in sight. worth remarking. Middle parts light winds. Standing boats Crews. All sail. Lat 59 south Long 97.03 West

Wednesday Sept 8th

Commenced with pleasant weather Employed in ships duty. mending the main sail. Plenty porpoises in sight. A M. nothing in sight. Lat 1.00 North Long 96.00 1/2 West
