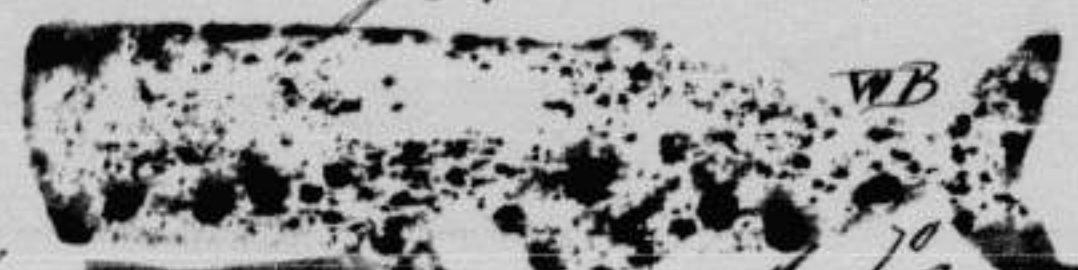


Ship Sector. of New Bedford

Tuesday July 5th 1842

Whales distant 8 miles dead to windward, 3 PM 2 1/2 miles off the weather beam. Lowered 3 boats. Struck, killed and took him to the ship. And set 4 watches for the night. At daylight saw a large whale off the beam going quick. Lowered but did not get sight of him out of the boats. 12 M. the boats all to the ship. So ends these 24 hours.



No Observation

Wednesday July 6th

Finished cutting the above whale, and brace full. Middie parts Employed in boiling. Latter parts fini. Saw finbacks. So ends these 24 hours. Lat 6.18 S. Long 103.11 W.

Thursday July 7th

Fine weather. Employed in boiling. Saw breaches to windward. 6 PM took in sail as usual. At 4 AM. Tacked to the N.E. Daylight saw a large whale. Lowered and struck him and took him to the ship. Latter parts more whales in sight.

Friday July 8th

Lowered 2 boats for the whales. Chased them out sight of the ship. Then we returned. got on board at 1 PM. Middie parts boiling. Latter cutting. At 11 AM. finished.

Lat South
Long West

On the Off shore Ground 1842

Saturday July 9th 1842

Employed in boiling, confusing breaking out, and starting bread. saw a whale. Carcass. Middie and latter parts fini. Employed in boiling. So ends.

Lat 6.04 South
Long 103.22 West

Sunday July 10th

Strong trades and clear weather. At 6 PM. took in main top gallant sail and flying jib. At 9 PM. finished boiling. Middie parts set the mainsail. Latter parts squally. Saw humpbacks. Lat 5.51 South Long 102.24 West.

Monday July 11th

Strong trades and squally weather. At 6 PM. doubled under the topsails. Latter parts blowing strong. Employed in stowing down oil in the fore hold. Saw nothing. Towed ship to the N.E. So ends.

Lat 6.32 South
Long 102.40 West.

Tuesday July 12th

Strong gales and squally weather. Middie and latter parts the same. saw finbacks. Employed in stowing down oil. So ends.

Lat 5.38 South
Long 101.32 West.

Wednesday July 13th

Strong gales from S.E. saw a ship stowing S.E.W. Latter part. finished stowing oil. So ends these 24 hours.

Lat 6.00 South
Long 101.33 West.
