

Cruising in the South Pacific Ocean

Monday September 12th 1842

Begins fine weather
Starboard watch on liberty. Bark Henry &
Margaret came to anchor. Latter part saw
a ship outside. Starboard watch on liberty. So ends.

Tuesday September 13th 1842

Begins fine weather
Starboard watch on liberty. Employed in blacking
the benches. Ship's boat came to anchor.
Latter. Employed in rafting water. So ends.

Wednesday Sept 14th 1842

Complete weather. 1 P.M.
took on board a raft of water. Made watch a
pleasant stand anchor watch as usual. Latter
Starboard watch on liberty. painting ship etc.

Thursday Sept 15th 1842

Begins clear weather
the watch Employed in painting ship. Ship
C. W. Morgan came to anchor. Mail part
fine. Latter clear weather. Ship Congrats arrived
So ends these 24 hours.

Friday Sept 16th 1842

Light breeze from the
sea bores. Employed in painting the ship. Sundown
the watch returns regular. Latter part
C. W. M. went to sea. Employed in bringing off
wood &c. So ends these 24 hours.

Log at Tumbes, Gray Master 1842

Sept 17th 1842

Commences clear weather. the
hands Employed in stowing wood and water
Charles Taylor, Thomas Young, Charles Jefferson
William Sadler, on shore without leave and
refuse to return on board. So ends these 24

Sept 18th 1842

Light trade and pleasant
weather. Employed in ship's duty. Evening
the Capt. of the port put the above mentioned
men in irons. Latter part. Employed in
getting ready for sea. So ends these 24 hours.

Sept 19th

Squally weather. At 3 pm took
the men on board. 6 P.M. went to sea
mail part. squally. 8 Am took the prisoners
out of irons. put them in the dunnage and gave them
one dozen each. sent them to their duty. So ends.
Lat 3. 03 South.

Sept 20th 1842

Commences with moderate trade.
Ship heading N.W. by N. by the wind. point St
Helena bearing N. N.E. 20 miles distant. Latter
part. saw a ship heading towards Tumbes. So ends
Lat 3. 04 South.

Sept 21st

Begins with light winds and pleasant
weather. Heading N.W. by N. by the wind. All
drawing sails etc. Latter part. the wind weather
about the same So ends Lat 1. 34 South
Long 84. 00 West

Begins with strong breeze and heavy
