 Remained with strong gale from N.E. and squally at 11 P.M.
 flying sail at 11 P.M. took it in again. had light breeze of

 118° 30' S. Long by arc 83° 41' W.

Saturday June 24th.
 Began with fresh breeze and squally standing to the Eastward under
