September 31st

First Post - Light Breeze middle and Latter Parts Strong Winds from W. S. W. Brig cruising off Bay of Biscay to sails in sight off Latter Post - kept off for Bay of Biscay

October 1st

Strong Breeze throughout - Brig off Bay of Biscay off Latter Post - the Captains came on board Brig of Bay of Biscay

October 2nd

Strong Breeze throughout - First Post - the Captain went on shore and the Boat came off and took the Brig into anchor in 12 faths of Water with 60 fms off and on Harbor anchor and 60 fms on Port anchor middle and Latter Post - blowing a heavy gale from S. W. sent down the fore Scaffolding the Captain on shore

October 3rd

of First Post - Blowing Very Strong Wind hauled to the N. W. Employed Braking out and getting Ready for to Brake out all middle and Latter Parts fine weather

October 4th

fine Pleasant - throughout getting Ready for sea with 10 lbs of Fresh Water onboard all hands on board

October 5th

fine Weather throughout - getting Ready for sea all hands on board

October 6th

first and middle Parts fine Weather Latter Post - Blowing Very Strong from S. E. with a heavy sea Running on Shore Alfred A. Rocha on shore sick & men Deserted a Million here Adolphus, Birmingham Walter Rogers and ashby

October 7th

fine Pleasant - Weather throughout getting Ready for sea. Alfred A. Rocha on shore sick

October 8th

of First Post - got under weigh and lay off and in Port went in at sundown some came off in the Boat Captain on shore Alfred A. Rocha Discharged Max Butler, Daniel Brown and Mary Batelle James Barrett - Peter Johnson came on board to go home in the vessel and the Brig off and on Captain on shore
