November 3rd

First-part Good breeze middle and latter parts
Strong breeze and hazy weather wind from west
Course S.E. by S. pumps carefully attended.

November 4th

First-part good breeze middle part blowing Strong latter
part blowing a gale with a heavy sea running and thick
weather and rain wind S.W. split the main sail course
S.E. pumps carefully attended to

November 5th

First-part blowing a gale from S.W. middle part
more moderate wind S.W. latter part good breeze
from East - thick weather and rain throughout
Course S.E.

November 6th

First and middle parts blowing Strong breeze after
thick weather and rain latter part light air and
calm saw one sail course S.E. by S. wind S.E. of
latter part rose the pt of Cadix and Flores dist 25
miles off bearing S.E.

November 7th

First and middle parts off the pt of Flores and about
came from shore and Repashe a B^{ty} at anchor look-
ing and her mast got a heavy gale on the 24 of
October and leaking of latter part Flores 25 miles off
a good breeze from S.W. Course S.E.

a gale from S.W. Rose the pt of Graciosa wore ship head-
ing to the N.W. and a heavy sea running thick weather
throughout

latter wind hauled to N.W. wore ship and all sails kept off course
S.W. by S. thick weather and rain throughout saw one sail

Blowing a very Strong throughout from N.W. & thick
weather and a heavy sea running of latter part rose the
pt of Bayal at 1 a.m. 25 miles off Course S.E. saw one
sail going S.W.

November 13th

First-part blowing Strong middle and latter parts light breeze fine
weather of First-part at 3 P.M. came to anchor in the harbour
of Bayal with 60 faths of chain on port anchor 70 on Starboard of
latter part the Captain and three men came on board to hold
Survey Employed braking out the main hatch

November 14th

Fine pleasant weather throughout Employed braking out bit
and vent of latter part the Captain came on board to
hold a Survey sent on shore boats

November 15th

Fine pleasant weather throughout wind from S.E. Employed
a braking out bit sent on shore boats

November 16th

Fine pleasant weather East breeze from S.W. Employed
braking out sending on shore boats

November 17th

Fine pleasant weather throughout Employed braking
out sent on shore boats and B^{ty}

November 18th

Fine pleasant weather throughout Employed braking out and
sending on shore boats and others through wind from S.E.
