October 21 1817
This 24 hours Begins with light winds and moderate weather the middle and last part clear High winds and pleasant weather See 20 plenty whales put off 5 times Could not strike Depth of water 45 fathoms Lat 39 59

Wednesday
October 22 1817
This 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant weather At 6 P.M. see whales put off after them but could not strike the last part pleasant weather All hands Employed in tarring down oil and scraping Bone Depth of water 50 fathoms No observation

Thursday
October 23 1817
The first part of this 24 hours pleasant weather the middle and last part thick and rainey weather Depth of water 52 fathoms No observation

Friday
October 24 1817
This 24 hours Begins with thick weather and rainy See 4 Sail Standing to the Eastward the middle and last part of this 24 hours Light winds and pleasant weather all hands employed in doing the ship duty Depth of water 55 fathoms Lat 39 59

Saturday
October 25 1817
This 24 hours begins light winds and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. Spoke the ship Indus of Cape Coffin the last part of this 24 Light winds and Pleasant weather Depth of water 54 fathoms Lat 40 16

October 26 1817
This 24 hours Begins with Light winds and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. See whales put off after them but could not strike this 24 hours ends with pleasant weather Depth of water 48 fathoms Lat 39 54

This 24 hours Begins with Light winds and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. See whale at 8 P.M. of and got one that made 35 blb. this 24 hours Ends with pleasant weather Depth of water 46 fathoms Lat
