Sunday Nov 16 1817
This 24 hours Begins with fresh gales and rainey See A
Plenty of Whales did put off after them the last part moderate See A plenty of Whales put off after them but did not strike Depth of water 50 fathoms Lat 45.15

Monday Nov 17 1817
This 24 hours Begins with moderate gales and pleasant weather the middle and last part fresh gales and rainey See A plenty of whales put off did not strike so ends this 24 hours Depth of water 51 fathoms No observation

Tuesday Nov 18 1817
This 24 hours Begins with fresh gales and foggy weather See Whales the middle and last part the same Depth of water 54 fathoms No observation

Wednesday Nov 19 1817
This 24 hours Begins with light winds and thick weather See A plenty of whales put off Could not strike the last part the winds and Cloudy Depth of water 48 fathoms Lat 45.10

Thursday Nov 20 1817
This 24 hours Begins with light winds and Cloudy weather See A plenty of whales put off and struck one the Spear raised and saw some the east boat so we had to go on board put off again with two boats fastened and saw Run to windward and were cut from him
This 24 hours ends with light winds and pleasant weather See A plenty of whales all Depth of water 48 fathoms Lat 42.58

Friday Nov 21 1817
This 24 hours Begins with light winds and pleasant weather See A plenty of whales Could not strike Depth of water 44 fathoms Lat 43.14

Saturday Nov 22 1817
This 24 hours Begins with light winds and pleasant weather See plenty of whales put off and got one whales that made up the last part of this 24 hours ends with pleasant weather See 4 ships and A plenty of whales put off Could not strike so ends this 24 hours Depth of water 47.11
