 on Cape August then bearing
 West by S Distance 20 miles
 Lat 6 = 43 Long 34 = 10 W

Thursday April 16 1818 This 24 hours Begins with
 Light winds and fresh
 gales and Squally weather the
 Middle and latter part fresh trade
 And pleasant weather
 Lat 4 = 41 Long 34 = 32 W

Friday April 17 1818 This 24 hours Begins with light winds
 Fresh gales I will say so if there
 be wind to the last part fresh trade
 and pleasant weather
 Lat 3 = 15 Long 35 = 44 W

Saturday April 18 1818 The first part of this 24 light and
 Pleasant winds the Middle and latter
 Part the Same with April Showers
 Lat 1 = 18 Long 36 = 54 W

Sunday April 19 1818 The first part of this 24 hours light
 Winds and rainy weather the Middle
 And latter part Squally with rain
 Lat 0 = 8 Long 38 = 6 W

Monday April 20 1818 The first part of this 24 hours light
 Wind and pleasant weather the Middle and
 latter part the Same So Ends this
 Lat 00 = 50 S Long 39 = 5 W

Tuesday April 21 1818 The first part of this 24 hours light
 Winds and pleasant weather the Middle and
 latter part the Same Squally with rain
 Lat 2 = 5 N Long 40 = 18 W

Wednesday April 22 1818 This 24 hours Begins with light winds
 Squally weather and rain the
 Middle and last part light winds and
 Cloudy weather Lat 2 = 20 Long 40 = 57 W

Thursday April 23 1818 This 24 hours Begins with light winds
 And Cloudy weather the Middle and
 last part Squally with rain So Ends
 Lat 2 = 58 N Long 42 = 10 W

Friday April 24 1818 This 24 hours Begins with Squally weather
 the Middle and latter part fresh
 gales Lat 4 = 8 N Long 43 = 38 W
