Monday
1849
The first part of this 24 hours
light winds and sailing to the south
part the same

At 11 P.M. Made the Island
of Trinidad bearing S by E
30 miles distant Sea calm
this 24 hours with light winds
and pleasant weather
Lat 21.00 Long 32.36

Tuesday
1849
This 24 hours begins with light
winds and pleasant weather

At 5 P.M. having the Staff and
Bait to go on Shore but could not
get lunch and returned to the ship
At 6 the Island of Trinidad
bearing S by W 4 leagues distant
from which I take my Dep.
this 24 hours ends with fresh
gales and cloudy with rain
Lat 18.29 Long 29.00

Wednesday
1849
This 24 hours begins with light
winds and pleasant weather

At 10 P.M. having the Staff and
Bait to go on Shore but could not
get lunch and returned to the ship
At 11 the Island of Trinidad
bearing S by W 4 leagues distant
from which I take my Dep.
this 24 hours ends with fresh
gales and cloudy with rain
Lat 16.39 Long 28.35
