Begins with fresh gale. All hands

Pleasant weather So Ends this

Begins with light fresh Trade and
Pleasant the Middle and Latter
part the Same So Ends this
Lat 41.14 N Long 48.10 W

Begins with fresh Trade and Pleasant
the Middle and latter part the
Same So Ends this
Lat 41.13 N Long 49.50 W
