of this 24 hours pleasant people employed
Doing Ships duty

This 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant
Sea & large with a great deal of windward
the wind East & East with pleasant
Weather people employed fitting the
Boats to Endeavour

Remarks on board Wednesday Sep 8th
The first part pleasant At 8 P.M.
tacked Ship and stood to N.E.
At 6 P.M. Set Standing sails fore
And aft steering E by N with the
South West to Endeavour this well pleasant

Lat 38° 42' N Long 48° 39' W

Remarks on board Thursday September 9th 1819
The first part pleasant and clear
the Ship with all sail set that will
Drive the last part the same to Endeavour

Lat 39° 04' N Long 48° 25' W

Remarks on board Friday Sep 10th 1819
The first Clear and pleasant the middle
And last part the same people employed
Doing Ships Duty steering East with
Wind S.W. to Endeavour

Lat 39° 36' N Long 41° 45' W

Remarks on board Saturday Sep 11th
This 24 hours begins with light winds and
pleasant the middle part fresh gale and
cloudy the latter part light winds and
pleasant steering E by S of the wind
South West to Endeavour

Lat 39° 58' N Long 38° 45' W

Remarks on board Sunday Sep 12th 1819
This 24 hours begins with light winds and
pleasant weather the middle part with fresh
the same steering E by S of the wind
South West to Endeavour

Lat 39° 34' N Long 38° 39' W

Remarks on board Sep 13th 1819
The first part of this 24 hours light winds
and pleasant the middle part fresh gale
steering E by S at 11 P.M.
pushed the topsails the wind N.E. then
E to Endeavour

Lat 39° 18' N Long 35° 45' W
