Commenced with strong Trades steering S by W variously employed Middle & fore part the same. employed repairing the fore top sail & top gallant sail ending with fine weather.

Strong Trades Ship by the third the fore top sail & top gallant sail employed repairing sails fore part the same. employed repairing the fore top sail. one sail in sight second

Moderate S & Trade winds steering S by W employed repairing sails one sail in sight middle and latter part wind light & employed breaking out for provisions. sent a new main sprit. Sailed with fine weather

Sunday Oct 31st

A light breeze S by W the fore top sail & top gallant sail steering S by W with fine pleasant weather middle & fore part the same. saw a small fish & a shoal of Black Fish but did not lower. so ends.

Monday Nov 1st

Commenced with fine Trades steering S by W with fine weather water variously employed Middle part squally with rain latter part strong Trades steering the same fitted on and sent up the cutters. gave new main braces fitted the fluke of the chains broke out the rigging in the fore hold and made a perfect mast secured the day. one ship in sight

Tuesday Nov 2^d

First part strong Trades steering S by W water variously employed latter part fore made steering S by W with pleasant weather employed breaking out between decks and making a black run S by W
