

Friday Dec 3d

Begins of end with fine pleasant weather wind  
N.E. steering S.E. by E with a heavy swell from  
the Southward, all sail and the port wheel  
gradually hauling to the Northward so ends

Lat by Meridian Altitude 37 37 S  
Long by Chronometer 9.19 E

Saturday Dec 4<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a strong breeze from  
the westward steering E.S.E. all sail set  
at 7 AM raised 20 whales lowered with  
out success at 9 AM lowered again struck  
and killed to the waist Boat down boats  
still fast to the whale one barque in sight

Lat by Meridian Altitude 37 47 S  
Long by Chronometer 00.09 E

Sunday Dec 5<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather upon the Northward  
at 2 AM took the whale along side commenced  
cutting finished at 8 AM sent all hands below call  
ed again at 5 PM at 8 raised 2 sperm whales  
lowered struck and sawed to the waist Boat spoke  
the Barque close under 20 barrels 4 months out  
so ends

Monday Dec 6<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with moderate pleasant weather from the  
North at 4 o'clock took the whale along side commenced  
meat cutting at 9 o'clock sunset and sent all hands below  
called again at 5. Middle part of the weather and  
showing strong breeze from the North commenced  
cutting at 8 AM showing strong sunset cutting and stacked  
the whale off to windward still blowing at 10 AM  
the fluke came past and the whale sunk so ends  
all hands employed clearing decks the barque in sight

Tuesday Dec 7<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with regular fine weather North East  
at 5 PM wind suddenly hauled to the North a heavy  
squall with rain Middle part fine weather started  
the works with what we saved of the sperm whale  
so ends matter employed sailing fine weather wind  
N.N.W. ship on either tack so ends
