Remarks Tuesday Dec 14th
Commences with a strong breeze from W. by N.
steering S. E. & under short sail middle part
the same. Latter part wind light & baffling
from W. S. W. to N. W. steering the same, employed
coasting oil. fine pleasant weather & one light
sight of ship during about 2 E. & 2 S. ends.

Wednesday 15th
Commences with moderate breeze from
N. N. W. steering S. E. wind gradually hauling to
the Northward. Latter part strong breeze from
the N. E. steering the same under double reefed top
sails & courses according the same.

Long by Chronometer 29.14 E.

Thursday Dec 16th
Commences with a strong breeze from N. N. E.
Starboard tack steering S. E. middle part more
moderate at 3 P. M. wind hauled to the North west
steering the same rather more east and cloudy.
Latter part moderate breeze & baffling from
N. N. E. west and cloudy weather. Do not
No observations.

Bound for the Crozet Ground

Friday Dec 17th
Commences with a strong breeze from the westward
with occasional squalls from W. S. W. all sail set middle
and latter part a gale from the N. W. under double reefed
top sails and fore sail at 1 P. M. wind increasing hauled
to fore and mizzen top sails secured.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 38.55 S
Long by Chronometer 27.18 E.

Saturday Dec 18th
Commences with a gale from the N. W. steering S. E.
under close reefed main top sail & fore sail. Middle
& latter part more moderate main top gallant sail. Watch
variously employed according.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 38.42 S
Long by Chronometer 30.42 E.

Sunday Dec 19th
Begins with a gale from the Westward under
double reefed fore & main top sails and fore sail
middle part gale increasing, took in the fore top sail
at 2 P. M. Latter part pleasant weather and still blowing
from W. with occasional heavy squalls. Do not, steering
South East.
