Friday Mar 25

Commenced with fine weather mild ~~at~~ Stearing NE by N
the Land in sight the West Coast of Australia. at 6 PM
made the light on Rottnest Island bearing N about 20
miles. at 8 PM more ship off shore wind S by E. Commenced
Lying aback making N by E. Middle part Lying aback
off and on the Harbour of Rottnest the light
bearing N by W dist about 20 miles at 9 PM Part
apilot. employed getting the anchors off the bow

Saturday March 26

Fine pleasant weather & a Moderate Breeze
from the SW the pilot on board Stearing for
the Harbour of Fremantle at 5 PM came to
anchor off the Town in five fathoms of water.
at 6 PM the Capt went on shore. Middle part
& latter fine weather with the Land & Sea Breezes
alternately. employed scrubbing ship & other port
duties & sundries

Sunday March 27th

Commenced with the Sea Breeze from SW
& fine weather got off two 1/2 Cords of timber & got
a raft of casks ash shore.

Middle & latter part overcast weather & a strong
Breeze seaward from SW employed in ship's
duties & sundries.

Lying at Fremantle West Australia

Monday March 28

Began with overcast weather mild S by N lying
at Fremantle weather fine employed in ship's duty
Middle part fine & pleasant Lying at Anchor in the
harbour of Fremantle employed painting ship filling
water & painting wood. received on board 6 Cords of wood

Three to Twenty Four Hours in Part

Fine pleasant weather Land Breeze from S by E Sea do.
from SW employed painting ship and other port
duties.

Middle part moderate and fine latter part
dull & still. Strong Breeze from S by W got off 12
barrels of water & stowed it down board.

Wednesday March 30

Fine weather & a strong Sea Breeze from S by W
variously employed in ship's duty

Middle part blowing strong with rain

Latter part fine weather & calm got off a raft of
timber and 2 young Potatoes employed in various
other jobs of ship's duty & sundries.
