Friday April 1st

Amidst breeze & fine weather wind S.W.
lying at anchor variously employed

Middle part moderate the Starboard watch
came on board from liberty at 7 P.M. at 8 o'clock
Larboard watch went on shore for 48 hours.
Latter part fine sounds.

In Part

Saturday April 2^d

Commences with fine weather & a moderate
Breeze from S.W. Middle part blowing
strong from S.W. Latter part much the same
the Larboard watch on liberty sounds

German to Western Australia.

Sunday April 3^d

Commences with a fresh Breeze from S.W. variously
employed. Two Men deserted one Boat Steward
& one Foremast hand Middle part the same
Latter part at 7 P.M. the Larboard watch came
from liberty ending with fine weather and
a light Breeze from E off the Land sounds

Monday April 4th

Begins with fine pleasant weather wind East
off the Land gradually hauling to the South

Middle part wind to the Southward & moderate
Latter part fine wind to the E making preparation
for sea with an hour before sunset sounds
one Foremast hand deserted.

Tuesday April 5th

Begins with fine moderate weather and
Land Breeze from E at 1 P.M. got under
weigh from the Harbour of German to
with a fine Breeze. Middle part steering NW
Latter part moderate Breeze from S.W. steering
N.W. & N.W. the Rich and Middle in sight
employed clearing ship & sending up the fore
& Mizzen top gallant yards & sails, sounds
