Thursday April 14

Fine pleasant weather wind southward
Ship on Eastern Tack employed
boiling some at spoke the Barge Ariel

Long by Chronometer no obs.

Friday April 15th
Commenced with fine weather from the Southward
Ship on Starboard Tack heading E employed boiling
spoke the Ship Europa of New Bedford 33 months
out 7800 barrels. Middle & latter part a moderate
breeze from S E Ship on either Tack employed
boiling some.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 24, 55 S
Long by Chronometer 106, 21 E

Saturday April 16th
Comes with a strong breeze from S E Ship on
either Tack saw two sails spoke the Europa
and gained employed boiling Middle & latter
part the same employed & wind the same
do ends.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 24, 18 S
Long by Chronometer 107, 15 E

Sunday April 17th

Commenced with a strong breeze
from S E Ship by the wind Starboard Tack
under double reef fore & Main by sails and jib
one sail in sight finished boiling at 2 AM
turned up 90 barrels Middle and latter part
the same
