Commences with fine weather from  
N.W. ship by the wind on either tack.  
Middle part overcast latter part the  
same with rain. Two sails in sight  
sends

Monday April 25-  
Commences with overcast weather with  
rain wind N.W. first part ship by the wind  
on port tack heading N.E. Middle part  
squally with rain ship under double reefed  
main top sail & fore sail. Middle part more  
moderate wind the same latter part all  
sail set ship on either tack employed  
setting up lower rigging one sail in  
sight sends

Tuesday April 26th  
Commences with fine weather and  
a fine breeze from N.W. ship on either  
tack water variously employed spoke &  
gained with the Barque Europa and ship  
Aligail of New Bedford. Middle part fine  
with the same latter part fine weather wind  
west steering E.S.E. two sails in sight water  
employed setting up rigging sends

Long by Chronometer 107.29. E

Wednesday April 27  
Commences with fine weather from the westward  
steering E.S.E. employed setting up rigging three  
sails in sight. Middle of latter part the same  
sends

Lat by Meridian Altitude 24.29. S  
Long by Chronometer 108.18. E

Thursday April 28  
Commences with fine weather from  
westward steering E.S.E. spoke the ship  
Europe & Aligail of New Bedford Middle  
latter part the same two sails in sight sends

Friday April 29  
Commences with fine weather from the  
westward more gradually hauling by the  
southward ship by the wind on either tack  
two sails in sight spoke the Aligail sends  
variously employed
