Saturday May 14

Begins & ends with strong breezes from the S.E. ship on either tack under short sail & the water variously employed several ships in sight.

Commences with a fresh breeze from S.E. ship by the wind on either tack with the water variously employed saw 6 sails, middle part the same latter part more made also spoke the Richard Mitchell sounds.

Monday May 16th

Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. ship by the wind on either tack several sails in sight middle part the same latter part shift blowing fresh from S.E. ship on either tack by the wind 3 sails in sight. sounds

Tuesday May 17th

Begins with strong breezes from S.E. ship by the wind on either tack under close reefed topsails & fore sail 3 ships in sight middle & latter part the same water variously employed sounds.
