Comes with strong breeze from S. E. ship the wind
under close reefed top sails & fore sail the sails in sight
watch employed hauling home middle part merrills
Latter part fine pleasant weather & a moderate
breeze from S. E. steering S. by S. S. spoke the
Stephan's watch variously employed sounds

Sunday May 22nd
Fine pleasant weather from S. E. steering S. by S. S.
two sails in sight watch variously employed
middle, & latter part the same sounds

by the wind on either tack employed breaking
