Saturday May 28
Commenced with haffling winds & frequent rain
small ship from South & Eastward ship on started back
heading from the S into S water variously employed at one
sail in sight Middle & latter part with a moderate breeze
from E S E steering SW by S employed backing out
providing one sail in sight saunders.

Sunday May 29
Commenced with fair pleasant weather from
E S E steering W by S one ship in sight water
variously employed Middle part under short sail
by the minel haffling. Latter part steering N by E
spoke the Barque J. A. Root & ship. Flower saunders
