Friday June 17 1859

Commenced with fair east weather & rain
Ship on starboard ^{with wind} heading E & gradually
min hauling to the Eastward at 10 AM anchored
South the sailing ship E 1/2 E ship under sheet sail.
Middle part strong breeze from S 1/2 S ship
thundering latter part the same heading S 1/2 W
at 7 PM raised sperm whaled lowered &
boat struck to the Harbor Boat & saved with
him along side commenced to receive falls at
10 1/2 ~~of~~ raised others lowered & boat missed
to the Harbor Boat and struck to the waist Boat
~~not recovered~~

Lat 17 3

Saturday June 18

The weather and strong breeze from
South eastward lying by the whale Boat
still fast killed him at 1 AM same made
to windward of the ship took him in
towed get him along side at 9 AM blowing
heavily while put him on the fluke chain
the shall bare out of his fluke and we lost
him it being impossible to go after him again.
Middle part still blowing latter part the
same called all hands at 1 PM and commenced
cutting down loggers sound
