Commences with light breeze and fine weather
all sail set wind the ship by the wind in harbor
tacks heading S.W. all hands employed doing
down middle & latter parts moderate employed
clearing and stowing bread between decks and
various other jobs about the ship & coals

Thursday June 30th
Commences with brisk breeze from S.E.
ship by the wind heading S. employed
clearing between deck all sail set middle part
moderate wind the same Lat too part strong
breeze from S.E. ship on harbor tack heading
S.W. in double reefed top sail watch
employed repairing a main top gallant sail
sails &c

Lat by Meridian Altitude 18° 27' S
Long by Chronometer 116° 09' E

Friday July 1st
Commences with strong breeze from S.E.
ship by the wind Starboard tack heading
N.E. watch employed repairing a main
top gallant sail middle part a strong breeze
from S.E. ship by the wind Starboard tack
heading S.W. watch employed repairing the
fore top sail & coals.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 19° 15' S
Long by Chronometer 116° 13' E

Bound for Turtle Island Saturday July 2^d

Commences with a strong breeze
from S.E. ship by the wind Starboard tack
heading S.W. employed mending sails
at 8 AM tacked ship heading N.N.E.
middle part moderate wind gradually hauling
to the Northward at 9 AM were ship to the
Eastward heading S.W. & watch variously
employed & coals.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 19° 00' S
Long by Chronometer 116° 40' E

Sunday July 3^d
Commences with a moderate breeze &
fine weather from North & Eastward ship
on Starboard tack heading S.W. & watch
variously employed at 8 AM were ship to
the Northward heading N.N.E. & moderate
later part the same at 9 AM tacked ship to
the Eastward all sail set heading S.E.
& coals.

Lat by Meridian Altitude 19° 01' S
Long by Chronometer 117° 08' E

Monday July 4th
Fine pleasant weather with S.E. ship on
harbor tack heading S.E. with all sail
set watch variously employed middle part
moderate heading from N.E. to N.N.E. latter
part a strong breeze from S.E. tacked ship
at 9 AM to the Eastward heading S.W. watch
variously employed & coals.
