sw lying at anchor saw no whales
middle part fine latter part the same
employed towing down sounds

Came with calm and fine weather employed
towing down middle part fine with a strong
breeze from SW latter part at 7 PM got under
weigh and start off shore saw
one boat in for turtle sounds

Saturday Aug 20

Begins with fine weather from westward ship under
weigh at 7 AM came to anchor and shipped our boat
by the Barque Cherokee of New Bedford marked
with the ship's name broadened & numbered with the
marking guns from 1 to 10 like wide the
initials. Middle & latter parts a strong breeze
from S.E. sounds

Sunday Aug 21

Begins with moderate fine weather first from
S.E. then gradually hailing to S.W. at 7 AM
came to anchor in 16 fathoms by the big Island
bearing S.W. & Be about Island S.E.
Middle & latter parts a strong breeze from
S.E. variously employed sounds
