Strong trade and the weather at 7 AM
Came to anchor in 12 fathoms. Am. er
Light house bearing N 60° W 18 miles
Middle part much rain. Latter part weather
better at 9 PM got under way and started
for the anchorage at 11 PM. Came to anchor
in 10 fathoms. Sailed.

Lying at anchor

Thursday 23
Moderate with frequent squalls.
all hands busily employed. Middle
part much rain. Latter part and moderate
employed working in recruits. At night
the anchor and stand for sea. Steaming N by W
Sailed.

Friday Sept 24
Came with a light breeze from the westward
Ship by the wind on either side. Working out
of the straits. Middle part squally with
thunder. Light rain. Sailed. Steaming N by W

Saturday Sept 25
Strong trade. Ship by the wind heading out
the straits. Cleared them at 9 PM at 10 knots
of the south west in our double reefed top sails
in company with the Abigail Sailed.

Sunday Sept 26
Begins with strong S. E. trade steering N W
in our double reefed top sails the Abigail in
sight. Watch variously employed. Middle part
squally with rain. Latter part fine & brisk
S. E. trade steering N S W Sailed.

Long by Chronometer 102.46 E

Monday Sept 27
Begins with fine weather and brisk S. E.
trade steering N S W the Abigail in sight
Middle part frequent rain squalls. Latter
part the same employed repairing the fore
top gallant sail and various other jobs. Sailed.

Long by Chronometer 109.58 E
