Begins with light breeze from the S.E. Ship lying under Starke island & Middle part. Strong breeze from the E.S.E. See one whale. The boats went in chase did not get him so ends this days work.

Thursday July 12

Begins with strong breeze from the S.E. with anchor under Starke island the boats are in to the island after turtle came off at 5 P.M. Middle part with the same latter part the land sounds.

Begins and ends with fine weather and a brisk breeze from Eastward to the Island bearing N.E. & S.E. distant 6 miles sounds.

Saturday July 14

Begins with a moderate breeze from E.N.E. lying at anchor with Island bearing the same all hands vigorously employed. Saw 4 whales lowered the launch boat without success. Middle part moderate latter part the same got under weigh and stood off shore sounds.

Sunday July 15

Begins with strong breeze. Middle part moderate lying at anchor latter part strong breeze ship under way saw several whales lowered with out success sounds.

Monday July 16

Begins with fine pleasant weather lying at anchor Middle part the same latter part a strong breeze from S.E. got under way at 5 P.M. and stood off shore sounds 6 ships in sight.

Tuesday July 17

Begins with moderate weather standing in shore spoke the James Brown of New Bedford Middle part fine latter part strong breeze took the anchor at 5 P.M. and off shore at 8 hoisted whales lowered 4 boats struck to the main boat and got badly stuck Ben Boat struck second boat and shag at 11 A.M. gave the line to one of the Splin chals Boats for halves sounds still part to the whales.
