 Begins with strong breezes from
 the ship on Starboard tack
 observing N.E. & the land in sight
 bearing about 6 dist about 20 miles
 saw several sails. Middle & Latter parts
 more moderate the land in sight.

 Long by Chronometer 62.54°E

Thursday Sept 6
 Begins with fresh breezes from
 E & S ship by the wind on either tack
 saw one sail Middle and Latter
 part fine one sail in sight several

 Long by Chronometer 63.06°E

Friday Sept 7
 Begins with fine breezes and pleasant
 weather steering N.E. saw the Barque for mail
 of New Bedford. the Island of Redoubt in
 sight. Middle and Latter parts fine
 sails in sight several

 Long No observations

Saturday Sept 8
 Begins with fine breezes ship on
 either tack the land in sight spoke
 & gained with the Barque America of
 Mattapensett & Parnassia of N.B. of
 Middle part the same as last seen
 the above vessels whaling kept off
 for the morning then three appeared
 at the side the whales going to seaward
 several.
 No observations

Sunday Sept 9
 Begins with moderate breezes the whales
 in sight several four Boats at 11 AM
 struck and saved 15 the Larborn &
 moist Boats kept the m along side at
 4 AM Boats still chasing. Middle
 part equally Latter part fine employed
 cutting finished at 11 AM one sail in
 sight several.
