Bayins with moderate breeze from SE all
sail set ship by the wind on either Tack the

Friday Sept 14

Bayins with strong breeze ship under double reef on
Main top sail & fore sail employed heeling down
Middle & Latter parts the same the land in sight.
Saw one sail over all.

Bayins with fresh breeze ship by the wind
on either Tack under double reef. fore
and main top sails on sail in sight. watch
variously employed. Middle part fine
Latter part the same the land in sight

fore & mizzen. and courses steaming from NE
to N. Soland.
