them up and came to the ship. at 6 AM
another school coming to leeward. Landed
3 boats dashed and missed to the last boat
boat went them up and returned to the ship
at 6 AM two other ships in sight both
whaling a large body of whales seen to day
employed flanking down Middle part fine
singing by the whale swords. employed cutting.

Monday Sept 24

Boys with a strong breeze 5 sails in
sight and cutting besides ourselves one
further at 7 AM. spoke to some whalers
120 sails the month. Middle and left
part fine 8 miles to leeward over the ship
on either side employed sailing.

Tuesday Sept 25

Boys with a strong breeze from SE
Ship by the wind on either side more
double reefed than three sails Middle and
Latter part the same employed sailing
swords.

Boys with a strong breeze from SE
Ship under double reefed sailing to the employed
sailing. Middle part the same Latter part
fine and sails in sight swords.

Thursday Sept 27

Boys with a strong breeze from
SE Ship by the wind on either side
employed sailing. Under sails in sight
Middle part fine Latter part the same
finished sailing. employed sailing
down swords. the same in sight sailing
& dist about 30 miles.
