 reef 5 miles in sight. Middle & latter
 part fine in play & making ship.
 The land in sight bearing E by N dist
 about 20 miles. Sees as
 Observations

Sunday Sept 30
 Begins with fine weather and a
 pleasant breeze. All sails set by the
 main & spoke the Barque Harvest of
 New Bedford 14 Mgals. set 400 spinn
 Middle part fine latter part the same
 all sail set & sail in sight one whale seen
 in each variously engaged

Monday Sept 31
 Begins with moderate weather all sail
 set ship by the main & spoke several miles
 in sight. Likewise the land bearing N by E dist

 Begins with moderate weather wind
 N & steering various courses through the day
 spoke and gained sight of the Flare &
 Pamela Middle & latter part the same
 the land in sight Sees as
 Observations

 Begins with moderate weather from
 the North more steering of the wind
 in company with the Pamela Middle
 part fine latter part moderate breezes
 from the all sail set & ships in sight
 Sees as
