Came with light breeze from the N.E. steering N.W. by N employed in sundry jobs sighted the land coast to heading S.W.

Middle and later part light breeze from the Eastward steering or rather lying with the main yard aback. Later part fine breeze from the Eastward steering W. by N the ship of Bourbon in sight employed in ship's duty took in the Bow Boat to repair her so ends this day's work.

Remarks on board ~~Friday~~ ^{Saturday} Nov^r 22 1860

Came with light breeze from the Eastward all sail out steering W. by N employed in sundry jobs land still in sight put out the launch boat Middle part spoke the Bark Permia and layed aback the rest part of the night heading to the S.W. Later part fine breeze from the Eastward employed in various jobs ship steering N.W. by W in company with the Permia Bark so ends this day's work.

Came with fine breeze from the Eastward ship steering W.N.W. employed in ship's duty the isle in sight also the Bark Permia a gale with no Middle part a light breeze from the Eastward lying with main yard aback heading off shore to the S.W. by E. Later part fine breeze the Eastward steering W. by N employed in various jobs about half past ten raised a merchant ship so ends this day's work.

Blow and Bark

Came with a fine breeze from the Eastward ship steering W.N.W. employed in ship's duty two ships in sight one merchant ship and the Permia Bark raised a school of killers and lowered thinking they were sperm whales. Middle part fine breeze lying with main yard aback. Later part a strong breeze from N.E. steering N.W. by W took in the Sabard Boat to repair her one sail the Bark Permia in sight so ends this day's work.

Remarks on board ~~Tuesday~~ ^{Wednesday} Nov^r 25 1860

Came with light breeze from N.E. employed in various jobs put out the Sabard boat the Bark Permia in sight steering N.W. by W Middle part light breeze from the Eastward ship lying main yard aback. Later part fine breeze from the same part steering W. by N one sail in sight so ends this day's work.

Lat 22° 17'

Remarks on board ~~Wednesday~~ ^{Thursday} Nov^r 26 1860

Came with light breeze from the N.N.E. and quite squally employed in ship's duty one sail in sight the Bark Permia Middle part light breeze from the Eastward lying with main yard aback heading the N.W. by N. Later part a fine breeze from the N.N.E. steering W.N.W. at eleven o'clock S. M. raised sperm whales lowered and in chase so ends this day's work.
