Come with the strongest breeze from S.E. lying to anchor in St. Helena. The weather equally one watch on liberty the stoward watch Middle & latter part the wind and with the same implored in painting see a plenty of ships and Embarked plenty of Marchenman passing by so ends this twenty four hours.

Tuesday February 26th 1861

Come with a fresh breeze from S.E. with patches of rain, implored in painting ship and watch on liberty Middle & latter part wind the same also the weather one watch on liberty implored in getting off Walter see a plenty of Merchant ship passing so ends this twenty four hours.

Wednesday February 27th 1861

Come with a fresh breeze from S.E. the weather cloudy ship lying to anchor in St. Helena harbor with a watch on liberty implored in getting off Walter Middle & latter part wind the same the weather equally implored getting off Walter finished at eleven o'clock P.M. one schooner and one ship whole ship gone in so ends this twenty four hours

Thursday February 28th 1861

Come with a strong breeze from S.E. ship lying to anchor in St. Helena. Implored in painting ship and side Merchant ships a plenty passing Middle & latter part wind the same the weather rather equally implored in painting ship and other small jobs so ends this twenty four hours.

Friday March 1st 1861

Come with fresh breeze from S.E. the ship lying to anchor in the harbor of St. Helena implored in painting ship one watch on liberty one Whaling schooner and one Whaler ship lying to anchor the day's and the John's Whaler from Desolation come Boarded for oil this twenty four hours ends in painting ship and other small jobs
