Came with Moderate Breeze from S.E. the ship under all sail under double reef, topails and courses and got employed in sanding lobes three sails in sight at five o'clock. At 6 P.M. Run off and gained with the bark under a running topail. More ship heading S.W. land bearing E.N.E. Middle part of Fresh Breeze from the same at daylight. Set Main sail and got at seven o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.

Monday, April 8th 1861

Came with a Moderate Breeze from S.E. the ship under double reef topail Main sail and got heading E.N.E. got employed in working ship three sails in sight three o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.

More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.

Spanner Whales, Came with Moderate Breeze from S.E. the ship under all sail during N.E. got employed in working the clipper at half past two o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. land bearing N.E. 6 P.M. Fresh Breeze from the same at daylight. Set Main sail and got at seven o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.

Came with fresh Breeze from S.E. the ship under short sail at daylight finished at three o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. land bearing N.E. 6 P.M. Fresh Breeze from the same at daylight. Set Main sail and got at seven o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.

Came with Moderate Breeze from S.E. the ship under Whole Main topail double reef fore and Mizzen and got employed in working ship three sails in sight during N.E. got employed in working the clipper at half past two o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. land bearing N.E. 6 P.M. Fresh Breeze from the same at daylight. Set Main sail and got at seven o'clock. P.M. More ship heading S.W. got employed in working ship three sails in sight land bearing N.E. thirty miles off so ends this twenty four hours.
