Monday July 15 commences with fine weather light variable cruising of green Charlots Island about part weather thick and rainy latter part fine so ends

/// Tuesday July 16 commences with fine weather light winds from S^W steering S^E about 4 latter part the same

/// Wednesday July 17 commences with thick weather strong winds from S^E & spoke Emily, Margaret & William Gifford so ends

/// Thursday July 18 commences with strong winds from S^W steering to S^E & at 6 P^M saw a right whale lower and struck took the whale to the ship and cut him in so ends

/// Friday July 19 commences with a heavy gale from S^E & ship have too much stress reefed ~~main~~ mizzen sail so ends

Saturday July 20 commences with strong winds from S^W ship under close reefed topsails heading to the S^W so ends

Cruising on Hoodae

Sunday July 21 commences with strong winds from S^W ship under short sail at 6 P^M spoke the barque Florance of Honolulu & whaler the ~~sea~~ seagoer about 4 latter part employed in boiling so ends

Monday July 22 commences with fine weather light winds from S^W steering to the Eastward all sail set employed in boiling & setting up shoals so ends Lat 57.29 Long 152.23

/// Tuesday July 23 commences with fine weather light breeze from S^W steering to the S^E & all sail set employed in boiling & setting up Shooks saw one bark to the S^E at 4 P^M spoke the William Gifford of New Bedford so ends

/// Wednesday July 24 commences with fine weather light breeze from S^W cruising of green Charlots Island spoke the William Gifford let her have 8 cask of bread saw 5 ships & 2 whaler employed in setting up shoals so ends

/// Thursday July 25 commences with fine weather & ship in sight at 2 P^M saw whaler lower far than the whaler going very quick did not strike
