

Ship *Almira* of Edgartown Capt Osborn 1867

Friday July 26 commences with fine weather
light wind from S E cruising of
green Charlots saw 6 ship so end
saw 2 right whales going quick to the
Windward

Saturday July 27 commences with light
wind and rang weather 6 ships
in sight saw the Emily Mergers
take a whale saw 3 whales going
to the S W part did not ~~come~~
down for them so end

Sunday July 28 commences with rang
weather light wind from E & E
saw one whale going to the windward
part down for him did not strike
saw one barge entering

Monday July 29 commences with fine
weather light wind 6 at 6
at 11 saw sperm whale down
for them struck one to Starboard
boat the whale sank head took
the line to the ship and parted
lost the whale at 2 P M
saw sperm whales again down
struck one to W boat and drew it
from him so ends weather
thick 6 P Land in sight land
dist 10 miles green Charlots Island

Wednesday July 30 commences with thick
weather strong wind from S W
cruising of green Charlots

Cruising on Hoodae 1867

Thursday July 31 commences with fine weather
light winds from S W stood in to
the land and sent two boats in
shore to look for fresh water at
6 the boats returned

Friday Aug 1 commences with thick
weather strong winds from S E
steering to the S W at 2 P M
have too heading S W so end

Saturday Aug 2 commences with light winds
from S W stood in for the land down
to boats and went on shore to
look for water found plenty of
water at 2 P M saw a right
whale down for him did not
strike so end

Sunday Aug 3 commences with fine
weather strong winds from
S W cruising of green Charlots
saw a good many hump backs
so ends

Monday Aug 4 commences with thick
weather and strong winds from
S steering for Foster Island
at part thick and rang wind
S E Land dist 15 miles so end

Tuesday Aug 5 commences with thick
weather strong winds from E
ship under short sail so end
