Wednesday Aug 6 commences with fine weather light winds from W steering by E for buckley bay at 9 o'clock came at anchor in 60 fathoms of water so Eng saw a few hump backs

Thursday Aug 7 commences with light winds from SE took the anchor and stood up the bay and came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water so Eng saw a good many humpback

Friday Aug 8 commences with thick weather and strong winds from SE 2 boats of a whaling struck one to starboard boat and sent from him so Eng

Saturday Aug 9 commences with thick weather strong winds from SE and rain so Eng saw good many humpbacks

Sunday Aug 10 commences with fine weather light winds Mod & Scatter part thick and rain so Eng

Monday Aug 11 commences with thick weather strong winds from SE so Eng

Wednesday Aug 13 commences with thick weather light winds from SE 2 boats of a whaling for Strick so Eng saw a few did not

Friday Aug 15 commences with thick weather strong winds from SE

Saturday Aug 16 commences with fine weather light winds from SE 2 boats of a whaling struck one to starboard boat and sank him in 20 fathoms of water sent a Bury to the whale so Eng

Sunday Aug 17 commences with thick weather strong winds from SE mod and later part blowing a gale from ESE sent more moderate so Eng
