Saturday Aug 31 commences with fine weather light winds from S.W. 3 boats of a whaling saw a few whales

Sunday Sept 1 commences with fine weather light winds from S.W. 4 boats of a whaling struck one to starboard and sank him in 75 fathoms of water

Monday Sept 2 commences with fine weather light winds from S.W. 4 boats of a whaling went to the whale and laid on him parted 2 of the lines but could not haul the whale up so ends
