whaling saw a good many whales
so ends

Monday Sept 9 commences with thick
Weather weather light winds from
S E & boats of whaling so ends

Tuesday Sept 10 commences with thick
Weather light winds from S W
At 4 o'clock took the anchor
and stood out to sea ahead
& later part clear so ends
Course S W

III
Wednesday Sept 11 commences with fine
Weather light winds from
W S W steering S under all
sail ahead part strong winds
from W steering S by W under
double reef topsails and courses
so ends

III
Thursday Sept 12 commences with strong
Winds from W S W steering
S under double reef topsails
ahead & later part more
moderate made sail so ends
Left by ab 52.55
Long by cor 157.00

III
So Wards. the Sandwich Islands 1861

Sept 13 commences with fine weather
Friday Light winds from S W steering
S by W all sail set employed in
making a breeze topgale at yard
Starting matter so ends

Left by ab 50.50
Long by cor 158.25

Saturday Sept 14 commences with fine
Weather light winds from S W
steering S by W all sail set ahead
part steering by E so ends

Left by ab 49.00
Long by cor 158.00

Sunday Sept 15 commences with fine
Weather strong winds from S W
steering S by E ahead part winds
S S W steering S & later part
Winds light so ends
Left by ab 46.01
Long by a cor 159.15

Monday Sept 16 commences with light
Winds from S S W ship heading S E
ahead & later part steering S E
so ends

II
Tuesday Sept 17 commences with fine weather
Light winds S W ship heading S S E
ahead part thick fog later part
clear so ends
