November the 23rd Day These 24 hours Commenced with
Boiling Cile & Strong breezes & at 1st rain and Coiled
Down the Works & blowing a Gale & C. and
At 4 Pm were Ship & wires in a mist and at 10 Pm
Ship shifted into the S.E. & blowing a Gale
and raining & at 7 Am all hands Carried &
Pumped Ship & rain & weather & got hauled
and blowing a Gale of wind and at 10 Got
Ship to work under way & blowing a strong breeze
Am Sounded these 24 hours & in Lat 40. 26. South
& Long 33. 48. West & C.

November the 24th Day These 24 hours Commenced
With Strong breezes & the watch in play in sailing and
At 6 Pm Set the watch & at 10 Pm rain and at
11 Am rain & at 6 Am finished Boiling and Strong
Breeze & C. and at 7 Am the watch Carried to Stowing
Down Cile and Sounded these 24 hours & Lat
South 40. 22 and Long 33. 38 West & C.

November the 25th Day These 24 hours Commenced with
Boiling & at 12 Saw right whale & lowered
Way & the Landward boats & the watch
At 6 Pm a piece of log at 6 Pm & began to
Rain but give it up and the watch let
Stowing & C. & at 5 Am all hands Carried
and went to cutting in the whale, but at 7 Am
Cut in one whale and these 24 hours end in cutting
The other whale & C. ending Lat
South 40. 14. & in Long 33. 13. West

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November the 26th Day These 24 hours Commenced with
Pleasant weather & cutting the 2nd Whale & at the
1st Am spoke the Ship War. Bosh of stonish
With 700. & 70 bbls of Cile & Whale & plenty of
This time and latter part pleasant weather and some
These 24 hours end in Lat South 39. 45. &
Long 33. 13 West & C. & C.

November the 27th Day These 24 hours Commenced
With Pleasant weather and the watch in play
Finishing Cile & C. Am at 4 Pm pleasant
and middle part rainy and at 6 Pm Showers of
Rain & at 7 Am went to Stowing Down Cile
Am latter part Strong breezes & Sounded these
24 hours and in Lat South 39. 42 and in
35. 35 West with 8 Sinner able Seamen.

November the 28th Day These 24 hours Commenced
Strong breezes & whale insight & all hands in play
In Ship duty & at 6 Pm Set the watch
and Cloudy heavy weather & C. and middle
part Strong breezes and at 7 Am a watch let
and Cloudy heavy weather & C. and latter the same
At 6 Sounded these 24 hours & in Lat South 39. 41
and in Long 36. 11. P. C. & C.

November the 29th Day These 24 hours Commenced with
Light breezes & Cloudy weather & the watch in play
In Boiling Cile & C. Am at 6 Pm finished Boiling
and light breezes & at 5 Am all hands Carried
and went to Stowing Down Cile & finished
Stowing Down at 10 Am & Sounded these 24
hours & in Lat South 39. 42 and in
36. 01 West & C.
