

The 21st Day These 2 hours commenced with
E. & S. wind & some squalls & at 1 P.M.
the morning & at 6 P.M. plenty of whales insight both
N. & middle parts right winds & pleasant weather & at 8
from all hands Catches & made sale of whales insight and
loured away but did not get the whale & came on
Board & at 6 A.M. loured away but did not get
the whale & came aboard in the rain & at 8 A.M. loured
The harbour while but did not get the whale & came
inboard in the rain & plenty of whales insight & at 10
some squalls but did not get the whale there were very
few come aboard & strong westerly & at 11 P.M. loured
but did not get the whale & came on board & some others
came in late South & at 8 P.M. went N.E.

January the 2^d Day there 2 hours commenced
Thence 8 & 3 Sail insight & at 1. Pm spoke
Thorndale Saghar hour with 1850 blbs of oil on
at 3. Pm saw whales & lowered away but did not
get the whale and at 4 Pm saw more whales and
lowered away & the waste boat got fast but
framed his karpison and the bar hour boat at
fast & framed next hook the loss time up the wh
made him Struck before but we saved the whale and
out & saw it him along and cut half of him on me at 9 Pm
left & set the two engines working & light sails & at 3 Pm
leaved all hands & finished cutting the whale & set the bar work
engines & continued sailing down the coast till 7 Pm but no success
in land south 45-6-4 Long 130-4-0 M. S. E. & C.
