Wednesday Dec 1st

Lat 33° 41' First part of this day a fresh breeze from the southward, all hands employed in breaking out the after hold and main hatch way at 5 P.M. hoisted the boats for exercise latter part a fresh breeze from the south steered by the wind heading E.S.E. so Ends

Thursday Dec 2nd

Lat 33° 01' First part of this day a fresh breeze from the southward, all hands employed in breaking out the after hold and main hatch way at 5 P.M. hoisted the boats for exercise latter part a fresh breeze from the south steered by the wind heading E.S.E. so Ends

Friday Dec 3rd

Lat 31° 23' Begins with a fresh breeze from the south steered by the wind to the S.E. latter part squally weather, saw a sail on the lee bow the watch employed variously so Ends

Saturday Dec 4th

Lat 29° 15' First part of this day a fresh breeze from S.E. by E. steered by the wind heading S by W. moderate and latter part continued much the same all hands employed in ship's duty so Ends

Sunday Dec 5th

Lat 26° 55' First part of this day a strong breeze from S.E. steered by the wind to the southward latter part continued much the same at 11 A.M. hoisted the top gallant sails saw a brig steering by the wind to the S.E. so Ends

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Monday Dec 6th

Commences with a strong breeze from the eastward with squally weather steered by the wind to the S.E. put on reef in the top sails latter part continues the same all hands employed in ship's duty so Ends

Tuesday Dec 7th

Lat 28° 10' Begins with a fresh gale from the eastward with squally weather steered by the wind to the S.E. latter part continues the same the watch employed in making simet so Ends

Wednesday Dec 8th

Lat 27° 22' First part of this day a strong breeze from E. by E. to E. steered by the wind to the S.E. moderate and latter part more moderate turned one reef out of the top sails and set the fore and main top gallant sails the watch employed in ship's duty so Ends

Thursday Dec 9th

Lat 19° 49' First part of this day a fresh breeze from S.E. by E. steered by the wind to the S.E. moderate and latter part continues much the same the watch employed in ship's duty so Ends

Friday Dec 10th

Lat 18° 21' First part of this day a fresh breeze from S.E. steered by the wind to the S.E. latter part continues the same so Ends

Saturday Dec 11th Commences with a strong breeze from S.E. steered by the wind to the S.E. at midnight saw the island of St. Antonio took a land stand off shore at 4 A.M. took a stand off for St. Nicholas with a strong breeze. Painted the long boat so Ends
